DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

In the above provisions El to E6 "experience" means experience in the industry, including experience in the employ of more than one employer, and any female employee mentioned in such provisions on leaving or being discharged from her employment shall be entitled to a certificate from her employer stating the date when such employment began and the date of its termination duly signed or otherwise authenticated by the employer. Such certificate shall be the property of the employee, and shall be returned to her by any subsequent employer within seven days of her engagement.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force except that in clause 1 of Schedule "A" the words a pieceworker shall be paid 36s. if a day worker or 39s. if a night worker for each full week worked" shall be altered to read a pieceworker shall be paid 41s. if a day worker or 44s. if a night worker for each full week worked."
