(A). ACTING DUTY ALLOWANCE.

Where an officer occupying any of the foregoing offices is directed by the Government Printer to perform the duties of any of the undermentioned offices, such officer shall be paid an hourly allowance where necessary to increase his remuneration to the rate of salary of the office in which he is acting:—

Binding, Head Finisher
Binding, Leather Cutter
Binding, Machine Folder, Head

Book Folder and Sewer (Female)
Composition, Foreman, Linotype (night duty only)

The hourly allowance to be paid to such officer shall be ascertained in accordance with the following formula:— $\frac{1}{2}$

 $\frac{A-B}{80}$

A = fortnightly salary of higher office.
B = fortnightly salary of the officer.

Provided that no officer shall be paid such allowance:-

(a) when the period of such performance is less than one hour,

(b) for a period longer than one month without the consent of the Board.

(B.) SPECIAL DUTY ALLOWANCE.

Officers performing any of the undermentioned specified duties shall be paid allowances at the following rates:—

(C). AWARD PROVISIONS.

The provisions of the Award for the time being of the Commonwealth Court of Conciliation and Arbitration for commercial printing in Melbourne shall, so far as they are applicable having regard to these Regulations and to existing practices observed in the Government Printing Office at the date of this Regulation, apply in respect of conditions of employment of officers in the Government Printing Office.

These Regulations shall have effect as on and from the 13th June, 1948. .
