Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1948.

BISCUIT BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 31st March, 1948, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence after the 4th March, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

Apprentices.

MALES.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 13s. per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 10s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.

MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 13s. per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 10s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
