Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1948.

Clause 2 of the Determination as published in Government Gazette No. 237 of the 21st April, 1947, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

For the purposes of this clause experience prior to 1st January, 1947, shall be calculated as follows:-

- (a) Any fraction of a year's experience shall be disregarded.
- (a) Any fraction of a year's experience shall be desired to be experience of five years only, and teachers with such five or more years of experience shall be paid at the sixth year rate for their next year of service and progress from year to year to the seventh, eighth, and ninth year in accordance with the above scale.

 The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply after the 31st December, 1949.
- (c) Experience of less than five years shall be taken into account and teachers with such experience shall be paid in accordance with the above scale.

Clauses other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
