# DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in November, 1948.

Except in the case of an apprentice or an improver, the minimum wage shall be, where the employer—

 (a) boards the employee with three meals per day, 16s. per week less, or
 (b) boards and lodges the employee, 21s. per week less.

†Note.-War Loadings: For convenience War Loadings as follows:-Males Females 4s. 0d. per week 2s. 6d. per week .. •• •• .. .. .. have been included in wages for employees classified under heading of other employees.

NOTE.—A copy of this Determination shall be displayed at or near the entrance of every establishment where the Determination of this Wages Board applies.

Under the provisions of Section 7 of the Factories and Shops Act 1936 (No. 4461) every employer of any employee in any Boarding ? House is required to keep a time-book or other record in the prescribed form wherein each employee shall enter daily a record of the financial worked.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force,
