DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Floor and Verandah Tiling.

When the aggregate amount payable for any job has been computed according to the piecework prices contained herein, such amount shall be increased by the addition thereto of a sum equal to an amount of one-sixth of such aggregate amount, and to such aggregate amount shall be added 1/10 that aggregate amount in consequence of the reduction of the ordinary working hours from 44 to 40.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 20, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
