DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 107s. 6d. per week.

Improvers.

One male improver to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 154s. 6d. per week.

One female improver to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 107s. 6d. per week.
