Police Regulation Act 1946.

POLICE FORCE OF VICTORIA.

DETERMINATION NO. 15 OF THE POLICE CLASSIFICATION BOARD.

THE Police Classification Board, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by the *Police Regulation Act 1946*, hereby makes the following Determination, that is to say:—

1. The Determination No. 1 of the Police Classification Board of the 13th November, 1946, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 22nd November, 1946, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) In Division IX., paragraph 1, Officers, delete the terms—
“Sub-Inspector f491”.
- (b) In Division II, paragraph 2, Sub-Officers, after the word “Sergeant” delete “First Class”; also delete the terms “Sergeant, Second Class f441”.

2. This Determination shall come into operation as from and including the seventh day of May, 1949.

POLICE FORCE OF VICTORIA.

DETERMINATION NO. 16 OF THE POLICE CLASSIFICATION BOARD.

THE Police Classification Board, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by the *Police Regulation Act 1946*, hereby makes the following Determination, that is to say:—

1. The Determination No. 2 of the Police Classification Board of the 13th November, 1946, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 22nd November, 1946, as amended by Determination No. 3, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) In paragraph 1, "Summer Uniform", delete the words "Second Class Sergeants" and "First Class".
- (b) In paragraph 9 (1) delete the word "Sub-Inspector".
- (c) In paragraph 9 (2) delete the words "Sub-Inspector—three white metal stars".
- (d) In paragraph 9 (4) delete the words "Second Class Sergeants—three chevrons of silver lace", also delete the words "First Class" in the last line.

2. This Determination shall come into operation as from and including the seventh day of May, 1949.
