LANDLORD AND TENANT ACT 1948.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria, passed in the twelfth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI; intituled the Landlord and Tenant Act 1948 it is amongst other things enacted that Parts I., II., III., IV., and V. of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or days to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette and different days may be so fixed for the coming into operation of any of the said Parts:

Now therefore I the Lieutenant-Governor of the State

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday, the 6th day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, as the day upon which the said Part V. of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1948 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this sixth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and in the thirteenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
