## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1949.

#### WHARF WATCHMEN.

- 3. (a) Wharf Watchmen—i.e. persons employed as watchmen in connexion with overseas and/or interstate shipping shall be paid as follows:—
  - (i) on wharfs and/or ships (excluding ships' holds) at the rate of 4s. 21d. per hour.
  - (ii) in ships' holds at the rate of 4s. 9d. per hour.
- (b) Wharf watchmen shall, if required by the employer, make appropriate notes in connexion with damaged or pillaged cargo.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
