Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Apprentices.
One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 164s. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.
One improver to every four workers receiving not less than 164s. per week of 40 hours.
