One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 145s. per week of 40 hours.

IMPROVERS.

Feather Duster Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 145s, per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 96s. 9d. per

week of 40 hours.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 145s. per week of 40

hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 96s. 9d. per Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 145s. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.
