#### ALLOWANCES.

- (i) To the amounts otherwise prescribed in this Determination shall be added the following:-
- (ii) Suitable overalls and gloves shall be provided by the employer for any employee mentioned in sub-clause (i) hereof.
- (III) The employer shall provide sultable washing conveniences for any employee mentioned in sub-clause (I) hereof, together with hot water or some other efficient cleansing material.

NOTE.—To the weekly earnings of each pieceworker the sum of 29s, shall be added, provided that where less than 40 hours are worked in any week, a proportionate amount shall be added in lieu of such sum.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
