Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 138.

GROCERIES—SUGAR—RETAIL PRICES.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 138.

Amendment.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 37, as amended by Prices Regulation Order No. 55, is hereby further amended by omitting from the Schedule thereto all reference to sugar of any grade or kind whatsoever.

Definition and Interpretation.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of twenty-five (25) miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;

“Country Area No. 1” means all that area of Victoria—
(a) comprised within the following municipal districts:—

Maximum Prices—Sugar.

4. (a) I fix and declare the maximum price at which Sugar 1A or Brown may be sold by retail in any of the areas specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order to be the price specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to such area.

(b) I fix and declare the maximum price at which Sugar, Icing and Castor, may be sold by retail in any of the areas specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order to be the price specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to such area.

(c) I fix and declare the maximum price at which Sugar, in Coffee Crystals and Loaf, may be sold by retail in any of the areas specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order to be the price specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to such area.

Exhibition of Price List.

5. Every retailer who sells or has for sale by retail in Victoria any of the goods specified in the Schedules to this Order, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of the Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any goods, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order, and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause, may be sold in Victoria by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 139.
THREE-PIN PLUG SOCKETS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 139.

Definition.

2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

"Metropolitan Area" means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Wholesale.

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which three-pin plug sockets may be sold by wholesale to be—

(a) in respect of sales for delivery within the Metropolitan Area:—

(i) Surface type—13s. 4d. per dozen.

(ii) Flush type—

Brown or walnut finish—15s. per dozen.

White, ivory, or cream finish—17s. per dozen.

(b) in respect of sales for delivery outside the Metropolitan Area:—

(i) Surface type—13s. 10d. per dozen.

(ii) Flush type—

Brown or walnut finish—15s. 6d. per dozen.

White, ivory, or cream finish—17s. 6d. per dozen.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Retail.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which three-pin plug sockets may be sold by retail to be—

(a) in respect of sales within the Metropolitan Area:—

(i) Surface type—1s. 4½d. each.

(ii) Flush type—

Brown or walnut finish—1s. 7d. each.

White, ivory, or cream finish—1s. 8½d. each.

(b) in respect of sales outside the Metropolitan Area:—

(i) Surface type—1s. 5d. each.

(ii) Flush type—

Brown or walnut finish—1s. 7½d. each.

White, ivory, or cream finish—1s. 9d. each.

5. (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which three-pin plug sockets specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

(2) All notices in writing given in pursuance of any Prices Regulation Order issued prior to this Order which operate to fix a lower maximum price for the sale by any person of three-pin plug sockets than the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order and which was in force at the commencement of this Order shall be deemed to have been given under this Order.

Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 140.

LIQUORS—VICTORIAN COUNTRY AREAS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 140.

Application.

2. This Order shall not apply to sales of fermented liquors in the Metropolitan Area.

Revocation.

3. Prices Regulation Order No. 1961, made under the Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations, is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Liquor or Liquors” means and includes ale, beer, lager, stout, porter, and any mixtures thereof, or any mixtures thereof with aerated waters;

“Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;

“Oz.” means fluid ounce or ounces as the case may be;

“4 oz. Glass” means any glass or similar container holding 4 ounces or more, but less than 5 ounces;

“5 oz. Glass” means any glass or similar container holding 5 ounces or more, but less than 7 ounces;

“7 oz. Glass” or “Long Glass” means any glass or similar container holding 7 ounces or more, but less than 10 ounces;

“10 oz. Mug or Pot” means any glass or similar container holding not less than 10 ounces.

Sales by the Glass in Public and Saloon Bars.

5. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any liquors specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by the glass in any public or saloon bar in the State of Victoria, other than the Metropolitan Area, to be the prices specified in such Schedule.

Sales in Dining Room or Lounge.

6. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any liquors specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold by any person in any dining room or lounge on licensed premises within the State of Victoria, other than the Metropolitan Area, to be the price specified in such Schedule.

Liquors in Schedules—Quantities Not Specified.

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any liquors specified in the Schedules to this Order may be sold in quantities other than those specified in the said Schedules to be the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order according as the sale takes place in a public or saloon bar or in a dining room or lounge as the case may be for the next smaller quantity of such liquors specified in the said Schedules, or, if there is no smaller quantity specified, then such price—calculated to the nearest downward half-penny as is in the same proportion to the maximum price fixed for the next higher quantity as the quantity actually sold, bears to the next higher quantity.

Non Listed Liquors.

8. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any kind of liquor (together with any container supplied therewith) for the sale of which a maximum price is not fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order may be sold by any person in the State of Victoria other than the Metropolitan Area, to be an amount computed at the rate of one half-penny for each fluid ounce of such liquor.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

9. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any liquor specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

10. Every person who sells or holds for sale by retail any liquors, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business in each of his places of business and in each of the bars, dining rooms, and lounges at such place or places of business, a notice or notices setting forth the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the sale by him of any kind and quantity of such liquors.
