DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

ALLOWANCES.

- (i) To the amounts otherwise prescribed in this Determination shall be added the following :--
 - .. 18. per day
 - .. An extra 1s.
- (ii) Suitable overalls and gloves shall be provided by the employer for any employee mentioned in sub-clause (i) hereot.
- (iii) The employer shall provide suitable washing conveniences for any employee mentioned in sub-clause (i) hereof, together with hot water or some other efficient cleansing material.

NOTE.—To the weekly earnings of each pieceworker the sum of 32s, shall be added, provided that where less than 40 hours are worked in any week, a proportionate amount shall be added in fieu of such sum.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
