Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Two improvers to each adult worker receiving not less than 164s. 6d. per week of 40 hours in the asse of a male adult and 99s. 6d. per week of 40 hours in the case of a female adult.
