### PUBLIC SERVICE ACT, 1946.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Public Service Act, 1946, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows:—

PART III-SALARIES, INCREMENTS AND ALLOWANCES.
