REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

PUBLIC SERVICE ACT, 1946.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act*, 1946, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows:—

PART III—SALARIES, INCREMENTS AND ALLOWANCES.

Regulation 48A.

Sub-regulation (3) is deleted, and the following sub-regulation is inserted in lieu thereof:—

“(3). The annual amount or range of salary assigned to each office classified in Classes ‘A1,’ ‘A’ and ‘A1,’ and ‘A’ of the Administrative Division shall be that entered opposite the name thereof in the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations.”

Regulation 60.

In sub-regulation (1) the annual rates of salary at the ages specified are deleted and the following rates are inserted in lieu thereof:—
