GAS REGULATION ACT 1933.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-ninth day of August, 1950.

REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the twenty-sixth day of May. 1950. His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, declared that on and after the date of the publication in the Government Gazette of such Proclamation the provisions of section 33 of the Gas Regulation Act. 1933 should have effect: And whereas the said Proclamation was published in the Government Gazette of the twenty-sixth day of May, 1950: Now therefore the Honorable Sir Charles Lowe, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the said State, by and with the advice of

the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 33 of the said Act, doth hereby make the following Regulations (that is to say):—

- 1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the "Gas Regulation (Emergency Powers) Regulations (No. 81)."
- (2) These Regulations shall take effect on the twenty-ninth day of August, 1950.
 - (3) The following Regulations are hereby revoked:-
 - (a) The Gas Regulation (Emergency Powers) Regulations (No. 75).
 - (b) The Gas Regulation Regulations (No. 76). (Emergency Powers)
 - (c) The Gas Regulation Regulations (No. 77). (Emergency Powers)
 - (d) The Gas Regulation Regulations (No. 78). (Emergency Powers)
 - (e) The Gas Regulation Regulations (No. 80). (Emergency Powers)
- And the Honorable Keith Dodgshun, His Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
