Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 186.

MILK-GEELONG AREA.

I N pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 186.

Amendment.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 152 is hereby amended by omitting clause 4 thereof and inserting in its stead the following:—

Maximum Prices-Geelong Area.

- 4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which milk may be sold for delivery in the Geelong Area, including any cost of delivery to the purchaser, to be—
 - (a) in respect of sales by wholesale—2s. 1½d. per gallon;
 - (b) in respect of sales by semi-wholesale-
 - (i) loose—3s. per gallon;
 - (ii) in bottles-3s. 4d. per gallon;
 - (c) in respect of sales by retail-

Per half pint	 	3d.	3½d.
Per pint	 	5½d.	6d. ·
Per quart	 	11d.	12d.

Provided that the maximum price for milk supplied to persons having milk delivered to them regularly in retail quantities of one pint or more per day shall be computed on a weekly basis by multiplying the total quartage delivered during such week by the maximum price per quart fixed by this clause.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 187.

HAND KNITTING WOOLS.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 187.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 70 is hereby revoked.

Application.

3. For the purpose of this Order and the Schedule thereto "hand knitting wool" includes all fingering yarns.

Maximum Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which hand knitting wools of the type and of the description specified in the Schedule to the Order may be sold by retail by the ball, skein, or twist to be the price specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

- 5. (1) Any person who sells or has for sale by retail any hand knitting wool, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall attach or display with such goods a ticket or label setting forth his selling price therefor.
- (2) Any ticket or label required by sub-clause (1) of this clause to be attached or displayed with any goods shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those goods and as to be properly associated with such goods.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any goods, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which are specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
