PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

(a) Apprentices.
One apprentices to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 289s. per week.

(b) Juvenile Workers.

One juvenile worker (i.e. a shop assistant not engaged in dispensing or compounding medicines, drugs or medicinal preparations, and who is under the age of 21 years) may be employed in any dispensary. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
