Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Henry Norman Jones, Acting Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in November, 1951.

MALES.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 216s. per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three smale workers receiving not less than 168s. 9d. per week of 40 female hours.

MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 216s, per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 168s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.
