Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 332.

CARTAGE RATES.—PRIMARY PRODUCE AND FERTILIZERS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 332.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 21 is hereby revoked.

Application.

3. This Order shall apply to the State of Victoria, except to the area within a radius of twenty-five miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Maximum Rates.

4. I fix and declare the maximum rate which may be charged for the service of transporting, including loading and unloading, any of the following goods, that is, wheat, rice, oats, maize or other grain or cereals or potatoes, chaff, baled lucerne, superphosphates or other inorganic fertilizers, for the distance specified in the Schedule to this Order, to be the rates set out in the Schedule opposite each such distance. Provided that if the person to whom such service is supplied assists or supplies assistance in the loading of those goods, the maximum rates fixed by the provisions of this clause shall be reduced by an amount calculated at 1s. per ton.

Variation of Maximum Rates by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum rates at which any service of transporting wheat, rice, oats, maize or other grain or cereals or potatoes, chaff, baled lucerne, superphosphates or other inorganic fertilizers, or loading or unloading, specified in a Notice in pursuance of this clause, may be supplied by any person to whom such Notice is given to be such rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person.

6. Nothing in this Order shall operate to nullify any provisions in respect to sales of whole, crusted or gristed wheat fixed by Prices Regulation Order No. 13 as amended by Prices Regulation Order No. 244.

Prices Regulation Act.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 334.

LIQUORS.—VICTORIAN COUNTRY AREAS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 334.

Application.

2. This Order shall not apply to sales of liquors in the Metropolitan Area.

Revocation.

3. Prices Regulation Order No. 140 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

4. In this Order and the Schedules thereto unless the contrary intention appears—

“Liquor or Liquors” means and includes ale, beer, lager, stout, porter and any mixtures thereof, or any mixtures thereof with aerated waters;

“Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;

“Oz. or Ozs.” means fluid ounce or ounces as the case may be;

“4-oz. Glass” means any glass or similar container holding 4 ozs. or more but less than 7 ounces;

“7-oz. Glass” or “Long Glass” means any glass or similar container holding 7 ounces or more but less than 10 ounces;

“10-oz. Mug or Pot” means any glass or similar container holding not less than 10 ounces;

“Reputed Pint” means 13 ounces;

“Reputed Quart” means 26 ounces;

“Nip” means 6½ ounces;

“Demi Nip” means 4½ ounces;

“Sales by the glass in a lounge or dining room” means sales of liquor by the glass either—

(a) in a lounge where seats and tables are provided in a separate room apart from the bar and where service is made by a waiter or waitress to the tables in the lounge; or

(b) in a dining room set apart for persons who partake of meals at the hotel and where service is made by a waiter or waitress to the tables in the dining room;

“Sales by the glass elsewhere than in a lounge or dining room” means sales of liquor by the glass which are not sales by the glass in a lounge or dining room.

Liquors Specified in the Schedules.

5. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any liquors specified in the Schedules to this Order may be sold by retail in the State of Victoria other than the Metropolitan Area, to be the prices specified therein.

Liquor in Schedules—Quantities Not Specified.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any liquors specified in the Schedules to this Order may be sold in the State of Victoria other than the Metropolitan Area in quantities other than those specified in the said Schedules, to be the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the next smaller quantity of such liquors specified in the said Schedules, or, if there is no smaller quantity specified then such price—calculated to the nearest downward halfpenny as is in the same proportion to the maximum price fixed for the next higher quantity as the quantity actually sold bears to the next higher quantity.

Non Listed Liquors.

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any kind of liquor (together with any container supplied therewith) for the sale of which a maximum price is not fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order may be sold by any person in the State of Victoria, other than the Metropolitan Area, to be an amount computed at the rate of one penny for each fluid ounce of such liquor.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any liquor specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

9. Every person who sells or holds for sale by retail any liquors a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business in each of his places of business and in each of the bars, dining rooms and lounges at such place or places of business a notice or notices setting forth the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the sale by him of any kind and quantity of such liquors.

BOOT AND SHOE REPAIRS—VICTORIA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 335.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 251 issued under the Prices Regulation Acts is hereby revoked.

Maximum Rates.

3. I fix and declare the maximum rates at which the services specified in the Schedule to this Order may be supplied in Victoria to be the rates specified therein.

Exhibition of Price List.

4. Every person who supplies or offers any of the services specified in the Schedule to this Order, the maximum rate for which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, particulars of the maximum rates fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the supply by him of those services.

Fixation of Maximum Rates by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum rates at which any service the maximum rate for the supply of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be supplied in Victoria by any person to whom such notice is given to be such rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person,

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 336.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, MILK DRINKS, FRUIT DRINKS,
RETAIL.—OUTER METROPOLITAN AND MORNINGTON PENINSULA AREAS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 336.

Revocation.

2. (a) Prices Regulation Order No. 219 is hereby revoked.
(b) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217 insofar as it relates to sales by retail shall apply to any goods the maximum prices for which are fixed under this Order.

Application.

3. This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
 "Outer Metropolitan and Mornington Peninsula Areas" means all that area of Victoria outside a radius of 27 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne, comprised in the Shires of—

Broadmeadows;	Frankston and Hastings;
Bulla;	Gisborne;
Dandenong;	Lilydale;
Doncaster and Templestowe;	Melton;
Eltham;	Mornington;
Fern Tree Gully;	Werribee;
Flinders;	Whittlesea.

 "Pure fruit drink" means any drink made from juice extracted from fruit (and wholly prepared on the premises of the vendor), with the addition of water or Aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient.
 "Fruit drink" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial, extract or syrup, with the addition of water, soda water, or other aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient.
 "Orange or lemon squash" means any drink made from orange or lemon (as the case may be) fruit juice, cordial, extract, or syrup, with the addition of soda water, or other aerated water.
 "Ice cream soda" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial, extract, or syrup, with the addition of aerated water and a minimum of one serve of ice cream.
 "Milk drink" means any drink of which milk is the sole or principal ingredient.
 "Oz." means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be.
 "Glass" means glass or other similar container.

*Bottled Aerated Waters, Aerated Fruit Drinks and Mineral Waters—
Sales by the Bottle.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks, of the description set out in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the person set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold by retail in the Outer Metropolitan and Mornington Peninsula Areas, to be the prices specified in the third column of such Schedule.

Provided that, where at the request of the purchaser, a bottle containing not more than 13 ozs. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, to the price applicable thereto, in accordance with the third column of the first Schedule to this Order, there may be added one halfpenny.

Sales other than by the Bottle.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the items specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold other than by the bottle to be—

- (a) where delivery is accepted at the counter, bar or self-service table on the premises of the vendor, the price set out in the second column of the said Schedule ;
- (b) where the items specified are served at tables or in foyer bars situated within a theatre or public hall, the price set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

7. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles, or other container containing any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks or milk drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

9. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 337.

BOTTLED LIQUORS.—VICTORIAN COUNTRY AREAS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 337.

Application.

2. This Order shall not apply to sales of bottled liquors in the Metropolitan Area.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

- “Liquor or Liquors” means and includes ale, beer, lager, stout and porter brewed and bottled in Australia;
- “Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;
- “Ballarat Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal post office at Ballarat;
- “Bendigo Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal Post Office at Bendigo;
- “Geelong Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal Post Office at Geelong;
- “Bottled” means a container of at least 26 fluid oz. or a reputed quart.

Sales by the Bottle.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any bottled liquors of the kinds described in the First Column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold at the places specified in that Column to be the price set out in the Second Column of such Schedule.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which bottled liquors specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person.

Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 338.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, MILK DRINKS, FRUIT DRINKS—
RETAIL—METROPOLITAN AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 338.

Revocation.

2. (a) Prices Regulation Order No. 218 is hereby revoked.
- (b) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217, insofar as it relates to sales by retail, shall apply to any goods, the maximum prices for which are fixed under this Order.

Application.

3. This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
- “Pure fruit drink” means any drink made from fruit juice extracted from fruit and wholly prepared on the premises of the vendor, with the addition of water or aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;
- “Fruit drink” means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of water, soda water or other aerated waters, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;
- “Ice cream soda” means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of aerated water and a minimum of one serve of ice cream;
- “Orange or lemon squash” means any drink made from Orange or Lemon (as the case may be) fruit juice, cordial, extract or syrup, with the addition of soda water or other aerated water;
- “Milk drink” means any drink of which milk is the sole or principal ingredient;
- “Glass” means glass or other similar container;
- “Oz.” means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be;
- “Metropolitan Area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 27 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Bottled Aerated Waters, Fruit Drinks and Mineral Waters—Sales by the Bottle.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks of the description set out in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold by retail in the Metropolitan Area to be the prices specified in the third column of such Schedule. Provided that where at the request of the purchaser a bottle containing not more than 13 ozs. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, to the price applicable thereto in accordance with the third column of the Schedule to this Order, there may be added one half-penny.

Sales Other than by the Bottle.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the items specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold other than by the bottle to be—
- (a) where delivery is accepted at the counter, bar or self-service table on the premises of the vendor, the price set out in the second column of the said Schedule; or
- (b) where the items specified are served at tables or in foyer bars situated within a theatre or public hall, the price set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

7. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles or other containers of any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks or milk drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

9. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business, at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER. NO. 339.

BREAD—VICTORIA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 339.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Orders Nos. 222, 225 and 252 are hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. (1) In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears:—

“Bread” includes white, brown, wholemeal, barley, rye or Vienna bread, whether or not containing fat or malt or sugar or milk or any product or by-product of malt or sugar or milk and whether or not made in accordance with the requirements of the *Bakers and Millers Act 1928* and whether in the form of loaves, buns or of rolls;

“Starch Reduced Bread” means starch reduced bread known and sold under any of the following trade descriptions or brands:—

“Borina”, “Bon Era”, “Broadway”, “Cenera”, “Ceralia”, “Conway”, “Denera”, “Diteen”, “Glyx”, “Golden Rayceri”, “Maltine”, “New Era”, “New Way”, “New Process”, “Nucera”, “Nutrena”, “Nutty Loaf”, “Nu Vitera”, “Oslo”, “Peerless”, “Procera”, “Progress”, “Promax”, “Provena”, “Provita”, “Rath’s Milk Loaf”, “Reform”, “Semola”, “Sta-fresh”, “Tricerum”, “Vita Loaf”, “Vitin”;

“Metropolitan Area” means—

(i) the municipal districts of the municipalities of Box Hill, Brighton, Brunswick, Camberwell, Caulfield, Chelsea, Coburg, Collingwood, Dandenong, Essendon, Fitzroy, Footscray, Hawthorn, Heidelberg (but not including the Greensborough ward), Kew, Malvern, Melbourne, Moorabbin, Mordialloc, Northcote, Oakleigh, Port Melbourne, Prahran, Preston, Richmond, Sandringham, South Melbourne, St. Kilda, Sunshine, Williamstown;

(ii) that part of the municipal district of the Shire of MULGRAVE which lies west of Bayview Road; and

(iii) that part of the municipal district of the shire of BROADMEADOWS which lies within the following boundaries:—

Commencing at a point on the easterly boundary at its intersection with Jukes-road thence westerly along Jukes-road to its intersection with Sydney-road thence southerly along Sydney-road to its intersection with Hilton-street thence westerly along Hilton-street and a line to the Melbourne-Seymour railway line thence along such railway line to its intersection with the Broadmeadows-Albion railway line thence south-westerly along such railway line to its intersection with Anselm-grove thence along Anselm-grove westerly to its intersection with Augustine-terrace thence along Augustine-terrace southerly to its intersection with the Broadmeadows-Albion railway line thence along that railway line south-westerly to its intersection with the Bulla-road thence south-easterly, easterly, northerly, easterly and northerly by the municipal boundary back to the commencing point; and

(iv) the Shire of KEILOR south-east of the Broadmeadows-Albion railway; and

(v) that portion of the municipal district of the Shire of WERRIBEE known as Altona bounded by the Melbourne-Geelong railway on the north; the Williamstown municipal boundary on the east, Port Phillip Bay on the south, and Maidstone-street and the Explosives Reserve on the west.

“ Provincial Cities ” means the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo and Geelong;

“ Main Towns ” means—

- (i) the towns or cities of Ararat, Bayswater, Benalla, Boronia, Camperdown, Castlemaine, Colac, Croydon, Echuca, Eltham, Epping, Frankston, Hamilton, Horsham, Kyneton, Maryborough, Mildura, Moe, Montmorency, Morwell, Nunawading, Ringwood, Seaford, Shepparton, St. Arnaud, Stawell, Swan Hill, Thomastowr, Wangaratta, Warragul, Warrnambool, Wonthaggi, Yallourn; and
- (ii) the Greensborough ward of the City of Heidelberg, and (to the extent that they are excluded from the Metropolitan Area) the municipal districts of the Shires of Broadmeadows, Doncaster and Templestowe, Keilor, Mulgrave and Werribee; but excludes the Shire of Mildura.

“ Mountain Towns ” means the towns of Buchan, Cann River, Corryong, Cudgawa, Eskdale, Icy Creek, Nayook, Noojee, Nowa Nowa, Omeo, Orbost, Swift’s Creek, Tanjil Bren, Tintaldra, Walwa and Woods Point;

“ By Wholesale ” includes, in relation to any sale of bread, a sale by a retailer to a person to whom that retailer has, on the day of sale, sold a quantity of bread (including that comprised in such first-mentioned sale) totalling not less than 12-lb. of bread; and, for the purposes of this definition, Vienna bread and Rye bread shall be reckoned as 2-lb. for each 24-oz. loaf and bread rolls as weighing 2-oz. each;

“ Booked Sale ” means, in relation to any sale of bread, that such sale is not a cash sale as defined in this clause;

“ Cash Sale ” means, in relation to any sale of bread, a sale where payment is made by the purchaser for the bread within 30 days of the date of delivery of that bread.

(2) Premises fronting on either side of any road or street which forms a boundary of any part of the Metropolitan Area shall be deemed to be within the Metropolitan Area.

Maximum Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bread specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold in Victoria by any person to be the appropriate price specified in that Schedule.

Fixation of Maximum Price by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which bread specified in a Notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold in Victoria by any person to whom such Notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

- (b) a Vienna loaf weighing less than 24-oz. shall be deemed to be a 1-lb. loaf and a Vienna loaf weighing 24-oz. or more shall be deemed to be a 2-lb. loaf;
- (c) a rye loaf weighing more than 24-oz. shall be deemed to be a 24-oz. loaf;
- (d) in respect of sales by retail, the price of each 1-lb. loaf shall be half the price of a 2-lb. loaf except where no other bread is bought at the same time by the same purchaser;
- (e) in respect of a booked sale outside the Metropolitan Area, the price shall be the price specified in the Schedule to this Order. plus
 - (i) ¼d. per 1-lb. loaf;
 - (ii) ¼d. per 2lb. loaf.
