Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1951.

BISCUIT BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 19 of the 12th January, 1951, shall be replaced by the following clause:-

Apprentices or improvers engaged attending gas ovens during the baking of wafers and branettes shall be paid 5s. per week in addition to above rates.

Apprentices.

MALES.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 187s. per week of 40 hours.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 147s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers. MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 187s, per week of $40\,$ hours.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 147s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.
