## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

##### Apprentices.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

##### Improvers.

One improver to every five or fraction of five workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

## LEADING HANDS.

(c) In addition to the appropriate wages rate prescribed in sub-clauses (a) or (b) hereof a Leading Hand shall be entitled to the following allowance:—

If in charge of 4 or less men .. .. .	.. 1/- per day.
If in charge of 5 to 8 men .. .. .	.. 1/6 per day.
If in charge of 9 men or more .. .. .	.. 2/- per day.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
