DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

Apprentices.
One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 260s. per week.

Improvers.
One improver to every ten or fraction of ten workers receiving not less than 260s. per week.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
