Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 216.

SCHOOL STATIONERY BOOKS.—SALES BY RETAIL.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 216.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 188 is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears:—
 - “Allowance for Cost of Transport” means, in relation to the sale of any specified goods, the allowance specified in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order;
 - “Cost of Transport” means, in relation to the sale of any specified goods, the cost of transporting such goods from the point of delivery to the store of the retail trader, but, wherever alternative means of transport are available to such retail trader, such cost shall not exceed the cost of the cheapest form of transport so available;
 - “Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;
 - “Point of Delivery” means, in relation to the sale of any specified goods by a retail trader, the place at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying those specified goods to his place of business passed to that retail trader from the person from whom the retail trader purchased such goods;
 - “Retail Trader” means a person who purchases any specified goods in a manufactured state, and resells or offers for sale such goods by retail;
 - “Specified Goods” means any of the goods specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order.

Maximum Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the specified goods may be sold by a retail trader to be—

- (a) for sales in the metropolitan area, the price set opposite thereto in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order;
- (b) for sales outside the metropolitan area, the sum of—
 - (i) the price set out opposite thereto in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order; and
 - (ii) the appropriate allowance for the cost of transport specified in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any specified goods may be sold by any person to whom a notice in pursuance of this paragraph is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

(2) All notices in writing issued prior to this Order which operate to fix a lower maximum price for the sale of any specified goods by any person than the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order, and which are in force immediately before the commencement of this Order, shall be deemed to have been given under this Order.

Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 217.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, TABLE WATERS, ETC.

I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 217.

Definitions.

2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“Non-intoxicating drinks” means any non-intoxicating drink, whether sold by the bottle or by the glass, of the following kinds:—
(a) Aerated waters;
(b) Mineral waters;
(c) Table waters;
(d) Drinks made from fruit juice, cordial, extract, or syrup with the addition thereto of water or aerated, mineral, or table water and with or without the addition thereto of any other ingredient.

“Prevailing price” means in relation to the sale of non-intoxicating drinks by any person the price at which that person sold on the 26th day of January, 1951, upon substantially the same terms and conditions, or if no sale of non-intoxicating drinks was made by that person on that date, on substantially the same terms and conditions, then the expression shall mean the price on the last preceding date upon which a sale of non-intoxicating drinks was made by that person upon substantially the same terms and conditions.

Application.

3. Nothing in this Order contained shall apply to any non-intoxicating drinks the maximum price for which is fixed under Prices Regulation Order No. 218 or Prices Regulation Order No. 219.

Maximum Price.

4. I hereby fix and declare the maximum price at which any non-intoxicating drinks may be sold to be the prevailing price.

Maximum Prices for Non-intoxicating Drinks not Previously Sold.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any person may sell any non-intoxicating drinks, which are not substantially identical with any non-intoxicating drinks which he sold on or prior to the twenty-sixth day of January, 1951, to be the cost of the goods to that person: Provided that on application by any person the maximum price at which those non-intoxicating drinks may be sold shall be such price as is fixed by notice by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner in writing to that person.

General.

6. Every person, other than a retailer, who sells non-intoxicating drinks for which a maximum price is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order shall deliver with the non-intoxicating drinks an invoice or docket containing the following particulars:—

- (a) His name and place of business;
- (b) The name and address of the purchaser of the non-intoxicating drinks;
- (c) The date of the sale of the non-intoxicating drinks;
- (d) The number and class of non-intoxicating drinks comprised in the sale;
- (e) The price per dozen or per unit as the case may be at which each lot of each class is sold.

Fixation of Maximum Price by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provision of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any non-intoxicating drinks may be sold by any person to whom a notice in pursuance of this clause is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

**AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, MILK DRINKS, FRUIT DRINKS—
RETAIL—METROPOLITAN AREA.**

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulations Acts, 1, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 218.

Application.

2. This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Pure fruit drink” means any drink made from fruit juice with the addition of water, soda water or other aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;

“Fruit drink” means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of water, soda water or other aerated waters, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;

“Ice cream soda” means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of aerated water and a minimum of one serve of ice cream;

“Milk drink” means any drink of which milk is the sole or principal ingredient;

“Oz.” means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be;

“Metropolitan Area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 27 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Bottled Aerated Waters, Fruit Drinks and Mineral Waters—Sales by the Bottle.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks of the description set out in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold by retail in the Metropolitan Area to be the prices specified in the third column of such Schedule.

Sales other than by the Bottle.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the items specified in the Second Schedule of this Order may be sold other than by the bottle in the Metropolitan Area to be:—

- (a) where delivery is accepted at the counter, bar or self-service table on the premises of the vendor, the price set out in the second column of the said Schedule;
- (b) where the items specified are served at tables, the price set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

6. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles containing any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks or milk drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

8. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business, at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, MILK DRINKS, FRUIT DRINKS—
RETAIL—OUTER METROPOLITAN AND MORNINGTON PENINSULA AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order :—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 219.

Application.

2. This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Outer Metropolitan and Mornington Peninsula Area” means all that area of Victoria outside a radius of 27 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne, comprised in the Shires of—

Broadmeadows ;
Bulla ;
Dandenong ;
Doncaster and Templestowe ;
Eltham ;
Fern Tree Gully ;
Flinders ;
Frankston and Hastings ;
Gisborne ;
Lilydale ;
Melton ;
Mornington ;
Werribee ;
Whittlesea.

"Fruit drink" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial, extract or syrup, with the addition of water, soda water, or other aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient.

"Pure fruit drink" means any drink made from fruit juice with the addition of water, soda water, or other aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient.

"Ice cream soda" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial, extract, or syrup, with the addition of aerated water and a minimum of one serve of ice cream.

"Milk drink" means any drink of which milk is the sole or principal ingredient.

"Oz." means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be.

Sales Other than by the Bottle.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the items specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold other than by the bottle to be—

- (a) where delivery is accepted at the counter, bar, or self-service table on the premises of the vendor, the price set out in the second column of the said Schedule;
- (b) where the items specified are served at tables, the price set out in the third column of the Schedule.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, fruit drinks, or milk drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

6. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.
