Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE TENNIS STRINGS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rate which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of making strings for tennis rackets, has made the following Determination, namely :—

1. That on the 15th March, 1951, clause 7 of the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 125 of the 2nd February, 1951, shall be amended to read :—

PAYMENT FOR HOLIDAYS.

7. All employees shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction of pay :—New Year's Day, Butchers' Picnic Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Melbourne Cup Day, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day.

SPECIAL RATES.

8. Double time shall be the rate to be paid for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Butchers' Picnic Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Melbourne Cup Day, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, then the special rate shall be payable only for the day so substituted.
