Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE WHARFS AND JETTIES BOARD.

Note.-This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board, which since the 10th November, 1927 has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the tradeof constructing or demolishing wooden or concrete wharfs, piers, or jetties," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st April, 1951, clause 7 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 53 of the 23rd January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

HOLIDAYS.

- 7. (a) An hourly employee shall be entitled to receive the following holidays without pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, but it any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the abovenamed holidays, the day so substituted shall be observed.
 - (b) An employee on weekly engagement shall be entitled to the above mentioned holidays without deduction of pay.
