Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SAND PIT BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board which since the 2nd October, 1939, has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in connexion with—A sand pit at labouring work, excavating, handling, or removing sand for trade or sale, or excavating, handling, or removing sand for the construction or the maintenance of roads, but not including persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Carters Board," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st April, 1951, clauses 7 and 8 of the Determination of this Board published in *Government Gazette* No. 110 of the 30th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

PAYMENT FOR HOLIDAYS.

7. All employees shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction of pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and Anzac Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays this condition shall apply only to the day so substituted.

SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

8. Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sundays, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, or Easter Monday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named public holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
