Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PHOTOGRAPHERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination since the 2nd July, 1946, has applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board which, since the 20th February, 1940, has had the power to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of taking, making, or doing any other work in the production of photographs, has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st April, 1951, clause 7 of the Determination of this Board [published in *Government Gazette* No. 107 of the 30th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SPECIAL RATES.

7. Double time shall be the rate payable for all work done on Sundays, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, and Melbourne Cup Day (Metropolitan District only), but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
