Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE LIMEBURNERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board which now has power "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of:—

- (a) making lime;
- (b) pulverizing or bagging limestone;

as made the following Determination namely:—

1. That as from the 1st April, 1951, clause 8 of the Determination of this Board published in *Government Gazette* No. 84, of the 26th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

8. (a) Double time shall be the special rate payable for all work done on Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

(b) An employee who is not required to work on any holiday prescribed in sub-clause (a) hereof shall be entitled to be absent from work on such day without deduction of pay.
