Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE NURSERYMEN'S BOARD.

Norm.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed by a nurseryman in the business or occupation of a nurseryman," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That on the 28th March, 1951, clause 7 o the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 126 of the 2nd February, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SPECIAL RATES.

7. Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, and time and a half for all work done on New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

Provided that, by agreement, King's Birthday may be substituted for Melbourne Cup Day.
