Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 15 (GROCERS).

Note.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, viz.:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder, the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Warrnambool and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wheresoever employed in the business of a grocer, including a seller of tea," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st March, 1951, clause 10 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 28 of the 15th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS.

10. Treble time shall be the special rate payable for all work done on Easter Saturday (i.e., the Saturday immediately succeeding Good Friday), and double time for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951. Christmas Day, and Boxing Day and within the Metropolitan District, Melbourne Show Day and Melbourne Cup Day, but, if any other day be substituted by Act of Parliament or Proclamation for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall be payable for work done only on the day so substituted.

All employees shall be entitled to the above-named holidays without deduction of pay.
