Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 1 (BOOT DEALERS).

Norz.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong Weat, Warrnambool, and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wherescover employed in the business of a seller of boots, shoes, or slippers, being a business usually or frequently carried on in a shop," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st March, 1951, clause 5 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 2 of the 15th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS.

5. Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, King's Birthday, Christmas Day, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Boxing Day, and within the Metropolitan District Melbourne Cup Day and after 12 noon on Melbourne Show Day. If any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays the rate shall be payable for work done only on the day so substituted. All weekly employees shall be entitled to the above-named holidays without deduction of pay.
