Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 21 (BOOKSELLERS AND NEWSAGENTS).

Note.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, viz.:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Warrnambool, and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board which now has power "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed—

- (a) in booksellers' or newsagents' shops,
- (b) in the trade of a wholesale bookseller or newsagent,
  - (c) in a lending library conducted for profit,"

has made the following Determination, namely:-

1. That as from the 1st March, 1951, clause 5 of the Determination of this Board published n Government Gazette No. 32 of the 15th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

## HOLIDAYS.

5. (Nothing in this clause shall apply to any employee who is required to work on any day mentioned therein in sonnexion with the sale or distribution of newspapers.) Employees shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction of pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Anzae Day, Labour Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day (Metropolitan District only). Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, and after 12.30 p.m. on Show Day in such localities mentioned in the Sixth Schedule to the Public Service Act 1946, as are within the area to which this Determination applies; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, this condition shall only apply for the day so substituted.

Any employee who is required to work on any day mentioned in this clause shall receive double time for such work.
