Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE CARETAKERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board which since the 5th April, 1939, has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to persons employed as caretakers of buildings—

- (a) in which any process, trade, business, or occupation is carried on for profit;
- (b) which are temporarily untenanted but in which, ordinarily, any process, trade, business, or occupation is carried on for profit;
- (c) which contain flats;
- (d) which contain halls let for public entertainment or for other purposes"—

has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That on the 17th March, 1951, clause 10 of the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 10 of the 3rd January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

### SPECIAL RATES.

10. Double time shall be the rate payable for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays the special rate shall be payable only for work done on the day so substituted.

Any employee other than one employed in connexion with halls who is required to work on any such days after 8 a.m. shall be paid for at least 4 hours' work.
