Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE MANUFACTURING CHEMISTS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

I N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of—

- (a) a wholesale or a manufacturing chemist;
- (b) manufacturing toilet preparations, perfumery, essences, essential oils, food preservatives, branding fluids, deciderants, disinfectants, fungicides, insecticides, vermin destroyers, weed destroyers,"

has made the following Determination, namely:--

1. That on the 28th April, 1951, clauses 7 and 12 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 59 of the 25th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

7. All employees shall be entitled to the twelve holidays hereinafter mentioned without deduction of pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Union Picnic Day, Labor Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, or such other day as may be substituted by Act of Parliament or Proclamation in lieu thereof, provided that any employee absenting himself or herself from work without reasonable excuse or without permission of the employer for any portion of the working day preceding or following a holiday provided for in this clause, shall not be entitled to payment for such holiday.

### SPECIAL RATES.

12. All work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Easter Monday, Good Friday, Labour Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day, Chrismas Day, and Boxing Day, shall be paid for at the rate of double time; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above holidays, the special rates shall be payable only for the days so substituted.
