Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 204.

BOOT AND SHOE REPAIRS—VICTORIA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 204.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 147 issued under the Prices Regulation Acts is hereby revoked:

Maximum Rates.

3. I fix and declare the maximum rates at which the services specified in the Schedule to this Order may be supplied in Victoria to be the rates specified therein.

Exhibition of Price List.

4. Every person who supplies or offers to supply any of the services specified in the Schedule to this Order, the maximum rate for which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, particulars of the maximum rates fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the supply by him of those services.

Fixation of Maximum Rates by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum rate at which any service the maximum rate for the supply of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be supplied in Victoria by any person to whom such notice is given to be such rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PURE LARD.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 205.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 195 is hereby revoked.

Maximum Prices.

3. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which pure lard may be sold to be the prices specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order I declare the maximum price at which pure lard, specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
