#### ALLOWANCES.

- (i) To the amounts otherwise prescribed in this Determination shall be added the following :-

- (iii) The employer shall provide suitable washing conveniences for any employee mentioned in sub-clauss (i) (hereof; together with hot water or some other efficient cleansing material.

NOTE.—To the weekly earnings of each pieceworker the sum of 81s. shall be added, provided that where less than 40 hours are worked in any week, a proportionate amount shall be added in fieu of such sum.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination as amended on the 19th February, 1951, shall remain in force.
