Factories and Shops Acts.

**DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE
FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).**

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1951.

CYCLE TRADE BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 30th April, 1951, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1951, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

And thereafter, until attaining the age of 21 years, four-fifths of the journeyman's rate.

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three persons receiving not less than 208s. per week.

And thereafter four-fifths of the journeyman's rate.

Provided that any improver who commences at the trade after attaining the age of 17 years shall be paid 20 per cent. in addition to the above rates.

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

One improver to one person receiving not less than 208s. per week, two improvers to two or three such persons, thereafter two additional improvers to every three additional such persons.

* Except those covered by the Apprenticeship Act.
