DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rate and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1951.

Clause 2 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 381 of the 12th April, 1951, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that, to the weekly earnings of each piece-worker shall be added the sum of seventy-six shillings. Where less than forty hours is worked in any week by any piece-worker, a proportionate amount of such sum of seventy-six shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
