APPBENTICES.

Broom Section.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 225s. 6d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piecework prices.

APPRENTICES.

Feather Duster or Mop Sections.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 225s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

IMPROVERS.

Feather Duster Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 225s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 164s. per week of 40 hours.

IMPROVERS.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 225s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 164s-per week of 40 hours. Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 225s. 6d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force provided that in clause 15 the amount of 117s. 6d, wherever appearing shall be increased to 127s. 6d.
