APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21-OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Henry Norman Jones, Acting Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1952.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 289s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers (Males).

Four improvers to each male worker receiving not less than 289s, 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Females.

Two improvers to each female worker receiving not less than 201s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

Definition of Juvenile Workers.

Persons other than apprentices or improvers under 18 years of age doing general work, i.e., all work

- (a) picking out or selecting.
 (b) making in the raw state.
- (c) twisting in the dry state.
- PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE). Males.

Six juvenile workers to each worker receiving not less than 289s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Females

Three juvenile workers to each worker receiving not less than 201s. 3d. per
