DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

(a) Apprentices.

One apprentice 'o every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 319s. per week.

(b) Juvenile Workers.

One juvenile worker (i.e. a shop assistant not engaged in dispensing or compounding medicines, drugs or medicinal preparations, and who is under the age of 21 years) may be employed in any dispensary. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
