Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 620.

ADMITTANCE CHARGES—FILM ENTERTAINMENT.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 620.

Definitions.

2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Film Entertainment” means entertainment by means of cinematographic film exhibitions supplied by any person or body of persons, whether corporate or incorporate, engaged in any commercial business profit making or remunerative undertaking or enterprise.

“Prevailing price” means in relation to the supply of film entertainment by any person, on any terms and conditions, the price at which that person supplied film entertainment on the 22nd day of February, 1954, upon substantially the same terms and conditions or if no film entertainment was supplied by that person on that date on substantially the same terms and conditions then the expression shall mean the price on the last day prior to the 22nd day of February, 1954, upon which film entertainment was supplied by that person upon terms and conditions substantially identical with the first-mentioned terms and conditions.

Maximum Prices.

3. I hereby fix and declare the maximum prices that may be charged for the supply of any film entertainment to be the prevailing prices.

Fixation of Maximum Price by Notice.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any film entertainment specified in a notice in writing given in pursuance of this clause may be supplied by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
