DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Note.—The Wages Board has determined that this trade is so unskilled that no person should be taken as an apprentice to it.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
