FURTHER PROROGUING PARLIAMENT AND FIXING THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE SECOND
SESSION OF THE THIRTY-NINTH PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS the Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the ninth day of February, 1954:
Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Thursday, the twenty-fifth day of February, 1954, and I do hereby fix Thursday, the twenty-fifth day of February, 1954, aforesaid, at the hour of half-past Two o'clock in the afternoon, as the time for the commencement and holding of the next Session of the said Parliament of Victoria, for the despatch of business, in the Parliament Houses, situate in Spring-street, in the City of Melbourne: And the Honorable the Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fifth day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, and in the second year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
