# DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Henry Norman Jones, Acting Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1954.

#### FARRIERS BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 572 of the 24th July, 1952, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

2. Wages.

PROPORTION (WITHIN ANY PLACE).

One apprentice or one improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

(a) Employed within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, and as Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Warrnambool, Castlemaine, Yallourn, and Frankston, and within the Gippsland district:—

Other Employees.

All Employees 286s, per week of 40 hours.

(b) Employed outside the areas specified in paragraph (a):— All Employees 283s. per week of 40 hours.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
