## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Henry Norman Jones, Acting Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1954.

#### IMPROVERS.

#### Feather Duster Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 253s, 6d, per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 185s, per week of 40 hours.

#### IMPROVERS.

#### Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 253s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 185s. per week of 40 hours.

#### Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 253s. 6d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force provided that in clause 15 the amount of 117s. 6d. wherever appearing shall be increased to 155s. 6d.
